ONE LAST IMPORTANT TIP TO MAKE YOUR EVENT RUN SMOOTHLY!

The DJ booth/area should be as close to the dance floor as possible so the DJ can easily and quickly do sound quality and volume checks, take requests from guests, and see important things (like when the Dollar Dance is over and the next song should begin). Many times people want to be put the DJ up on a balcony or deck. As close to the dance floor as possible is the best place for the us! We bring our own table and chairs, so we do not need your venue to set up a table for us —just leave us a space near an electrical outlet on the edge of the dance floor.
